In this month of November, we pray for our departed loved ones.

When we stroll through a cemetery, we see the names of many we do not know. We trust that someone still knows them, still remembers them, still prays for them. We hope that someone will remember the good we have done and the life we led, when we have gone.

In his Letter to the Thessalonians, in a passage often used at funerals, St Paul consoles a group of Christians about the dead. The Thessalonians wonder if their dead are lost forever. Paul answers that there is no need to grieve. For 'we believe that Jesus died and rose again, and that it will be the same for those who have died in Jesus: God will bring them with him'. Further on he continues, 'those who have died in Christ... shall stay with the Lord forever. With such thoughts as these you should comfort one another'.

Our cemeteries are reminders of those who have gone before us, but also beacons of hope for the living. For no matter how long or how short our lives, how many people we met, or who has remembered or forgotten our names, there is One who always remembers, who has the power to raise us up to a new and eternal life, where we pray we will be reunited once more.
