A son, a father, and a brother.

Each of them gives a different perspective for us to contemplate.

We can see selfishness, remorse, forgiveness, relief, joy,

indignation, jealousy and shame.

Through its different views, the parable also shows the social

dynamic of sin, showing how selfish choices affect not just

ourselves, but can ripple through family, social circles,

and communities, generating hurt and more sin along the way.

Forgiveness seeks to smooth these ripples, mend these broken

relationships. We are left hoping that through the father's exam-

ple of forgiveness and joy, the two brothers found reconciliation

also.
