Masses on Sunday 26th December are at the usual times and all other masses
over the Christmas season will be outlined in detail in our Christmas
Newsletter and posted in our 4 churches.

We, the 3 priests of the parish, are also looking after the parishes of Annaduff
and Bornacoola and have been doing so for a considerable period of time. As a
matter of interest, we will be celebrating 15 masses from Friday, Christmas
Eve, to Sunday 26th. As a result we regret that we are unable to provide
Christmas masses in our 3 churches of Gowel, Jamestown and Leitrim. A
further consideration is that due to ongoing Covid concerns we would only be
able to accomodate about 110 people in total in these 3 churches whereas we
can have 150 or more people at one mass here in St. Mary's. We continue to
ask for your understanding and patience until such time as the Covid situation
in our country changes dramatically.

We also take this opportunity to pay a special tribute and say a heart-felt
'Thank You', to all our stewards who have done such wonderful work in
guiding and helping our parishioners over the past 22 months.
