Celebrating Christ the King

Our Liturgical Year comes to a close as we celebrate the feast of Christ the King
on Sunday 21st November'21. It may seem strange to think that we are ending
our year in a somewhat 'triumphalist' manner but the kingship that Jesus wishes
to exercise over our lives has nothing to do with wanting to have power, control or
dominion over us. The kingdom that Jesus proclaimed is not so much about an
address as it is about a way of life or a particular mind-set. It is about having a
wholesome appreciation of what is right, good and proper. Above all, it is about
being true to ourselves and doing our best to make a difference in the lives of
other.

We will fail in our allegiance and loyalty to Christ the King
if we don't seek, earnestly, to grow in our relationship with him.

- He invites us to be his brothers and sisters, not his subjects.
- He is not hidden behind palace walls but rather lives in our hearts.
- He did not inherit his royalty but rather he earned it,
being crowned with the thorns of his suffering
and nailed to the throne of his Cross.
He did all of this as testimony to the truth of his great love for us.
- Each time we celebrate the Eucharist, we're invited to dine at the King's Table,
as he invites us to share in the life he offers us
He comes to us, not on the clouds of heaven,
but in the simplicity of this meal which is the sacrifice of his life.

He comes to claim dominion over us
by laying down his life in service of us
and inviting us, as members of his royal family,
to do the same for one another.
