DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY: will be celebrated in St. Mel's Cathedral at 1pm

A — Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.

B — Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.

C — Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust. The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive.

Ways of Divine Mercy, Saint John Paul II

Speak of God's mercy: Share it with family, friends and co-workers who are worried or fretful.

Practice works of mercy: Use the Church's list of spiritual and corporal works of mercy as a guide.

The Corporal Works of Mercy: Feed the hungry; Give drink to the thirsty; Clothe the naked; Give shelter to the homeless; Visit the sick and imprisoned; Ransom the captive; Bury the dead

The Spiritual Works of Mercy: Instruct the ignorant; Counsel the doubtful; Admonish sinners; Bear wrongs patiently; Forgive offenses willingly; Comfort the afflicted; Pray for the living and the dead.

Pray to obtain mercy: Pray for yourself, of course, but pray for others as well. Naturally, the people you know and love will be at the top of your list, but pray for strangers, too. Pray for the world as a whole, which is so desperately in need of God's mercy.

Let Mary be your guide: Saint John Paul called her "the Mother of Divine Mercy." Through Mary's prayers we can receive God's mercy and learn to be merciful to others.

Chaplet of Divine Mercy: Pray it daily.

Deepen your love for Jesus: Increase our trust in his Divine Mercy. Including: frequent attendance at Mass; regular confession, because in this sacrament especially we experience the mercy of God; Eucharistic adoration; daily spiritual communion, turning our hearts and minds to Jesus.
