

MYSTERY OF THE HOLY TRINITY

The mystery of the Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. God reveals himself as Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The doctrine of the Trinity includes three truths of faith.

Firstly, the Trinity is one. We do not speak of three gods but of one God. Each of the Persons is fully God. They are a unity of Persons in one divine nature.

Second, the Divine Persons are distinct from each other. Father, Son and Holy Spirit are not three appearances or modes of God, but three identifiable persons, each fully God in a way distinct from the others.

Third, the Divine Persons are in relation to each other. The distinction of each is understood only in reference to the others. The Father cannot be the Father without the Son, nor can the Son be Son without the Father. The Holy Spirit is related to the Father and the Son who both send him forth.

All Christians are baptised in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

“Go therefore, make disciples of all nations; baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teach them to observe all the commands I gave you.” (Matthew 28:19.)

In Chapter 1 of St John’s we read: *“In the beginning was the Word: the Word was with God and the Word was God.” Also – The Word was made flesh, he lived among us. And we saw his glory, the glory that is his as the only Son of the Father, full of grace and truth.”* Later we read: *“I shall ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you for ever, that Spirit of truth whom the world can never receive since it neither sees or knows him; but you know him, because he is with you, he is in you.”*
