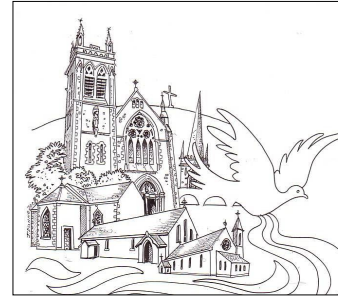


Solitude
